As required, I conducted the requisite Public Hearing in Conference Room A. of the County Office Building at 9:30 am on March 28, 1988 regarding the proposed Local Law "Establishing Certain Rules Regarding the Operation of All Terrain Vehicles (Hereinafter 'A'TVs') Within Rensselaer County'.

All of the individuals but one who attended this Public Hearing spoke emphatically and quite eloquently, in opposition to the Local Law, citing adverse consequences, both personally and business-wise were such a Law adopted. The one person who spoke in favor was Legislator Jane Doughney. One person spoke and presented Rules and Articles of New York State Law relative to the subject matter of the Public Hearing. Considerable discussion ensued and the overwhelming concensus was unreserved opposition to the proposed Local Law. But, I add, that by the conclusion of the discussion, Legislator Doughney indicated her agreement with those persons who spoke in opposition to the proposed Law.

Accordingly, and in consideration of the testimony presented at the Public Hearing, I hereby notify you that I have vetoed this proposed Local Law.

## LOCAL LAW NO. (INTRODUCTORY) OF THE YEAR 1988 (WITHDRAWN BY SPONSOR)

A local law in Relation to the Civil Service Classification of Certain Employees in the Rensselaer County Sheriff's Department.

Be it enacted by the Rensselaer County Legislature of the County of Rensselaer as follows:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. The Rensselaer County Legislature hereby finds that those employees of the Rensselaer County Sheriff's Department whose job duties are in the Civil Division of the Sheriff's Department should be categorized differently than those employees performing law enforcement or correction functions. The Rensselaer County Sheriff is directly responsible for their actions, and as a result, the Rensselaer County Legislature further finds that those positions in the Civil Division should be exempted from inclusion in the classified service.

Section 2. Amendment of Local Law No. 7 for the Year 1984. Those job titles involved in solely civil functions in the Civil Division of the Rensselaer County Sheriff's Department shall be hereby exempted from the list of titles included in the classified service pursuant to Local Law No. 7 for the year 1984. However, the present incumbents in said positions shall continue to hold their titles, and may only be removed from said positions for incompetence or misconduct, pursuant to the terms of the collective bargaining agreement between the parties.

Section 3. Separability. If any provision of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not effect impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the particular provision directly involved in the controversy.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing.
