A local law PROVIDING THE MAXIMUM TERM FOR WHICH THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF RENSSELAER COUNTY MAY LEASE REAL PROPERTY FOR COUNTY PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the RENSSELAER COUNTY LEGISLATURE of the

of RENSSELAER, NEW YORK as follows:

SECTION 1. Thirty Year Term. Notwithstanding Section 215 of the New York State County Law, the County of Rensselaer is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement in connection with any real property necessary for County purposes for a term not to exceed thirty years. Any such lease agreement may provide for the renewal thereof, provided that the term of each such renewal shall not exceed thirty years.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence of this local law is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 1.

Subsection B of Section 6.02A of the Rensselaer County Charter, as added by a local law of the year 1995, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6.02 A Bureau of Economic Development and Planning

B. There shall be a County Planning Advisory Board of not less than nine nor more than fifteen members, each appointed by the County Executive in accordance with Section 3.04 hereof, one member upon the recommendation of the Chairman of the Legislature and one member upon the recommendation of the Minority Leader of the Legislature, and which shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Director of Economic Development and Planning in matters pertaining to county planning and as assigned by the Director.

LOCAL LAW FILING

SECTION 2.

Section 6.08 of the Rensselaer Charter, as added by a local law of the year 1995, is amended by adding a new subsection C as follows:

C. There shall be a Public Safety Advisory Board of fifteen members, each appointed by the County Legislature, one member upon the recommendation of the Chairman of the Legislature and one member upon the recommendation of the Minority Leader of the Legislature, two members upon the recommendation of the County Executive, one member shall be a volunteer firefighter, one member shall be a professional fire fighter, one member shall be a police officer, one member shall be an emergency medical technician, one member shall be upon the recommendation of the New York State Division of State Police, one member shall be upon the recommendation of the Rensselaer County Sheriff, one member shall be upon the recommendation of the Rensselaer County Fire Chief's Association, one member shall be upon the recommendation of the Rensselaer County Ambulance Association, one member shall be upon the recommendation of the Rensselaer Organization United for Senior Endeavors, one member upon the recommendation of the Rensselaer County Fire Advisory Board, and one member upon the recommendation of the Rensselaer County Traffic Safety Board, which shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Director of the Bureau of Public Safety.

SECTION 3.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.





Section 1. The County of Rensselaer hereby elects to provide all of its eligible employees with a retirement incentive program authorized by Chapter 30, Laws of 1996.

Section 2. The commencement date of the retirement incentive program shall be September 30, 1996.

Section 3. The open period during which eligible employees may retire and receive the additional retirement benefit, shall be ninety (90) days in length.


Section 4. The actuarial present value of the additional retirement benefits payable pursuant to the provisions of this local law shall be paid as one lump sum or in five annual installments. The amount of the annual payment shall be determined by the Actuary of the New York State and Local Employees Retirement System, and it shall be paid by the County of Rensselaer for each employee who receives the retirement benefits payable under this local law.

Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately, and as provided in the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
