WHEREAS, Police reviewed surveillance cameras and discovered Cramer-Machia headed North on Route 4, wearing a North Face jacket, pants and with only socks on her feet in roughly 10 degree weather; and

WHEREAS, North Greenbush Police Officer John Hudson and State Police Senior Investigator Eric Cullum walked along Route 4 shining flashlights down the ravine and about a third of a mile from where she was last seen they spotted Cramer-Machia near a tree about 30 feet down the slope; and

WHEREAS, Hudson and Cullum climbed down and found Cramer-Machia alive, but severely hypothermic; and

WHEREAS, Officers deployed rescue ropes and pulled the two officers and Cramer-Machia up the side of the ravine where an ambulance was waiting to take her to the hospital; and
