WHEREAS, Effective January 1, 2024, Berkshire Farm will provide Rensselaer County with one reserved bed, at a per diem rate of \$574.72, and will accommodate an additional non-secure detention request only if the unreserved bed is available and remains available, at the same per diem rate of \$574.72; and

WHEREAS, If an unreserved bed becomes unavailable the County will need to remove the youth by 5:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, The Rensselaer County Board of Elections (the "Department") wishes to extend the terms of (3) contracts with the New York State Board of Elections: Poll Worker Training/Voter Education (#C002564), New York State Accessibility/Poll Site Improvements (#T002680), and HAVA/SHOEBOX funding (#C003240); and

WHEREAS, The current contracts, as noted above, were most recently extended through March 31, 2023, as per Resolution No. G/158/22; and

WHEREAS, Unused grant funds from all three programs from the department's 2022 budget were never rolled forward into the department's 2023 budget and there was no program activity within 2023; and

WHEREAS, This Resolution is filed with the Rensselaer County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Per Resolution No. G/419/22, the County of Rensselaer was awarded and accepted \$38,186.67 in funding through the New York State Board of Elections (NYS BOE) Absentee Ballot Pre-Paid Postage Grant Program, for the period of July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Unused grant funds from the department's 2022 budget were rolled into their 2023 budget by Resolution No. G/110/23; and

WHEREAS, This Resolution is filed with the Rensselaer County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, New York State Board of Elections has previously notified the Rensselaer County Board of Elections of available funds through the NYS Capital Projects Budget to establish the Technology Innovation and Election Resource (TIER) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, These funds are to reimburse local dollars spent to further implement the capital purchase of software, technology upgrades, equipment and broadband service; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. G/292/21 authorized acceptance of the TIER Grant award in the amount of \$160,509.35 for reimbursable expenses as above-noted for the period of April 7, 2021 through January 27, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Unused grant funds from the department's 2021 budget were rolled into their 2022 budget by Resolution No. G/157/22; and

WHEREAS, Per Resolution No. G/375/23, the Rensselaer County Board of Elections was notified of an extension for this grant, resulting in an amended contract period of April 7, 2021 through January 28, 2024, with an additional award of \$133,832.54 to be added to the remaining original grant funding; and

WHEREAS, There was no 2023 activity within this grant, and further review of the program has determined that not only are there additional funds available for the department's use, but that the term of the grant has actually been extended through March 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Given the above, the Board of Elections seeks to roll the remaining amount of this grant funding into the 2024 Rensselaer County Adopted Budget; and

WHEREAS, This program is fully funded by State monies and will produce no fiscal impact on Rensselaer County; now, therefore, be it
