

## RESOLUTION URGING GOVERNOR CUOMO AND THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO RESTORE AID AND INCENTIVES TO MUNICIPALITIES FUNDING IN THE STATE BUDGET

**WHEREAS,** During the presentation of the New York State budget, Governor Cuomo announced a nearly \$60 million cut in funding for Aid and Incentive to Municipalities (AIM) funding; and

**WHEREAS,** Towns and villages in Rensselaer County and throughout the State are highly dependent on this funding for municipal operations throughout the year; and

**WHEREAS,** Many of these towns and villages have already established their municipal budget for this year; and

**WHEREAS,** In the absence of AIM funds, towns and villages may be forced to raise taxes or make cuts to programs and services in order to close budget gaps; and

**WHEREAS,** After protests from local governments across the State, Governor Cuomo proposed a new "Internet Sales Tax" that would create a new tax on internet purchases made by county residents; and

**WHEREAS,** This Internet Tax unnecessarily shifts the state's burden to local taxpayers who already pay some of the highest taxes in the nation; and

**WHEREAS,** Forcing counties to use a portion of the Internet Sales Tax to make the budgets in their towns and villages whole does not reduce property taxes or offset the costs of services to our residents; and;

**WHEREAS,** AIM funding was a relatively stable number that was included in local budgets but could now become a number that fluctuates dramatically based on internet purchasing trends of residents; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That this Legislative Body voices its opposition to the cuts in AIM funding and the proposal to replace it with a new Internet Sales Tax, and urges Governor Cuomo and the New York State Legislature to restore AIM funding to its previous line in the New York State Budget; and, be it further

**RESOLVED,** That the Clerk of the Rensselaer County Legislature send a certified copy of this resolution to Governor Andrew Cuomo, Senator Neil Breslin, Senator Daphne Jordan, Assemblyman Jake Ashby, and Assemblyman John McDonald.

## RESOLUTION URGING GOVERNOR CUOMO AND THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO INCLUDE FUNDING TO REIMBURSE COUNTIES FOR CHANGES TO THE ELECTION PROCESS

**WHEREAS,** It is the duty of this Legislative Body to adopt a balanced County budget that complies with the New York State mandated property tax cap in December of each year; and

**WHEREAS,** In January of this year, Governor Cuomo and the New York State Legislature enacted several election reforms including early voting, same day voter registration, and expanded voting hours which will significantly increase costs to each county; and

**WHEREAS,** An early voting center would require the center to be staffed for 10 days before Election Day, and requires the purchase of up to \$300,000 worth of electronic polling books that would be required to track voting at multiple locations; and

**WHEREAS,** A ballot on demand system will cost approximately \$12,000 for each early voting center and additional staff will be required at each voting center, causing costs of elections to rise; and

**WHEREAS,** The county budget did not include funding for the costs of these newly mandated reforms to the voting process, Rensselaer County will be required to make significant budgetary changes to comply with these new voting regulations; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That this Legislative Body hereby requests that Governor Andrew Cuomo and the New York State Legislature reimburses Rensselaer County for all of the costs of complying with the newly adopted election reforms; and, be it further

**RESOLVED,** That the Clerk of the Rensselaer County Legislature send a certified copy of this resolution to Governor Andrew Cuomo, Senator Neil Breslin, Senator Daphne Jordan, Assemblyman Jake Ashby, and Assemblyman John McDonald.

## RESOLUTION URGING GOVERNOR CUOMO AND THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO NOT REDUCE MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENTS TO COUNTIES

**WHEREAS,** It is incumbent upon this Legislative Body to protect the residents of Rensselaer County and to defend their interests when decisions by State leaders could affect them; and

**WHEREAS,** While addressing a potential gap in the New York State Budget, Governor Cuomo proposed a total of \$550 million in cuts to Medicaid; and

**WHEREAS,** Governor Andrew Cuomo has announced his intention to cut approximately \$75 million from the Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Program (CDPAP) of the statewide Medicaid program that allows people to choose the providers of their own at-home care; and

**WHEREAS,** The Governor has also proposed a 0.8 percent cut in reimbursements to Medicaid service providers; and

**WHEREAS,** One of the many impacts in that reduction in reimbursements would be a sharp reduction in reimbursements to ambulance services in Rensselaer County, many of which are volunteer agencies with limited budgets; and

**WHEREAS,** The Mental Health and Hygiene bill (S.1507, A.2007) would eliminate Medicaid payments for low-income and elderly patients that are insured by both Medicare and Medicaid, a move that will cost statewide ambulance companies approximately \$14 million per year; and

**WHEREAS,** It is the sense of this Legislative Body that Governor Cuomo and the New York State Legislature should not make cuts that reverse the State's investment in critical services to the elderly, those with developmental disabilities, low income residents of our State, and to those who provide these critical services; and now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED,** That this Legislative Body opposes the cuts to Medicaid funding in the Governor's proposed budget; and, be it further

**RESOLVED,** That the Clerk of the Rensselaer County Legislature send a certified copy of this resolution to Governor Andrew Cuomo, Senator Neil Breslin, Senator Daphne Jordan, Assemblyman Jake Ashby, and Assemblyman John McDonald.

## RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2018 AND 2019 RENSSELAER COUNTY ADOPTED BUDGETS - PUBLIC DEFENDER, CONFLICT DEFENDER AND COUNTY ATTORNEY

**WHEREAS,** This Resolution is filed with the Rensselaer County Legislature by the Rensselaer County Executive; and

**WHEREAS,** The Rensselaer County Public Defender, the Rensselaer County Conflict Defender and the Rensselaer County Attorney received a grant totaling \$272,073.00 (Distribution #3 - Contract No. C000338) from the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services for the period from June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2016, pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution No. G/226/14; and

**WHEREAS,** Resolution No. G/189/16 authorized the extension of this grant to May 31, 2017, Resolution No. G/290/17 authorized the extension of this grant to May 31, 2018 and Resolution No. G/268/18 authorized the extension of this grant to May 31, 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** There are unexpended monies for the Offices of the Public Defender, Conflict Defender and County Attorney; and

**WHEREAS,** The following lists the amount of funds remaining in each of the original accounts, which need to be budgeted within 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** All purchases, made under this grant, will be done under the purchasing guidelines set forth in the Purchasing Policies and Procedures of the County of Rensselaer; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That any positions, programs, expenditures and/or agreements or contracts authorized or established pursuant to this resolution shall terminate and cease upon discontinuance of said funding; and, be it further

**RESOLVED,** That the 2018 Rensselaer County Adopted Budget shall be and hereby is amended as follows:




