RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF COVID-19 TEST KITS FOR COUNTY SCHOOLS
- DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

WHEREAS, This Resolution is filed with the Rensselaer County Legislature by the Rensselaer County Executive; and

WHEREAS, The Rensselaer County Department of Health ("RCDOH") previously accepted funding from the New York State Department of Health ("NYSDOH") in the amount of \$3,890,436.00 for the period of July 1, 2021 through July 31, 2022, as per resolution G/285/21; and

WHEREAS, This funding is to establish COVID-19 screening/testing programs to support and maintain in-person learning (including public, private, BOCES, and charter schools, as applicable) and to support school-based screening/testing activities intended to reopen schools; and

WHEREAS, The financial resources provided are required by law to support school-based screening/testing activities intended to support open, in person K-12 school environments during the COVID-19 pandemic. Additionally, these resources may be used to support items or activities aimed at implementation of prevention strategies necessary to curtail the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Per resolution G/340/21, the RCDOH has obtained COVID-19 testing machines for each school located within Rensselaer County in order to assist in the rapid identification, electronic reporting, monitoring, analysis, and evaluation of control measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. There are currently 58 public, private and charter school buildings within Rensselaer County; and

WHEREAS, RCDOH has obtained a quote for an additional 232 test kits at a cost of \$984.00 each, for a total cost of \$228,288.00, from the manufacturer Abbott, such equipment and supplies are obtained through their supplier McKesson, P.O. Box 936279, Atlanta, GA 31193-6279; and

WHEREAS, These additional test kits will be used to replenish the supplies at County schools that have been previously provided a testing machine; and

WHEREAS, This purchase is in accordance with Rensselaer County Purchasing Guidelines and is funded within budget appropriation code A.4017.04800.SCHOOLS.2021.04800; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, The 2022 theme is "Cultivating a Community of Care": Recognizing that the prevention of sexual violence and supporting survivors is a shared responsibility among all community members. In addition, lifting the stigma around sexual assault will encourage victims to come forward and prosecute attackers and allow authorities to provide victims assistance and help to heal; now, therefore be it
