WHEREAS, The Parties understand and agree that the current benefits and terms and conditions of employment for the covered employees in place as of the date of employers sign this MOA shall remain in place and no modifications shall be made to the benefits and terms and conditions until a collective bargaining agreement is agreed upon between the Employers and UPSEU; and

WHEREAS, The Parties will meet to begin negotiations for an original collective bargaining agreement as soon as practicable following legislative approval of the MOA, with the collective bargaining agreement being effective when agreed upon by the Parties; now therefore, be it

WHEREAS, The system also establishes and maintains a database utilized to produce mandated reports such as the New York State Commission of Corrections' Daily Population Report, the Sheriff's Annual Report as well as revenue generating reports such as Parole Reimbursement Reports, State Ready Reports, Social Security Reports and Alien Assistance Reports; and

WHEREAS, The service contract is necessary to ensure continued technical support, software updates, training and user input into future assessment and needs of next generation software packages; and
