WHEREAS, This Resolution is filed with the Rensselaer County Legislature by the Rensselaer County Executive; and

WHEREAS, Resolution G/69/22 authorized amending the 2022 Capital Projects budget by accepting a grant through the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, Resolution G/399/23 authorized amending the 2023 Capital Projects budget by accepting a grant from the Clean Water Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, Resolution G/401/23 authorized Bond Financing for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Capital Project H1207, stating the estimated maximum cost thereof is \$14,214,000, appropriating said amount therefor, and authorizing the issuance of \$13,914,000 of serial bonds; and

WHEREAS, The 2025 Capital Project needs to be increased by \$1,000,000.00 to proceed with project costs; and

WHEREAS, Resolution G/221/22 and G/265/22 authorized the Rensselaer County Sewer District to receive allotments of \$3,000,000.00 and \$3,000,000.00 of Rensselaer County ARPA funds; and

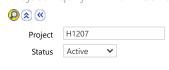
